She received a BA in Voice Performance from West Virginia Wesleyan College and an MM in Opera and Music Theater from Southern Illinois University of Carbondale. After graduate school, Mrs. Ungureanu-Biser became a college professor teaching voice, music appreciation, and music history at John A. Logan College, Southeastern Illinois College, and Southern Illinois University. Many of her students have been a part of their local community theater musicals, and have been awarded full scholarships at several universities including University of Memphis, Millikin University, and the Chicago College of Performing Arts. Since moving to the Memphis area, Mrs. Ungureanu-Biser has been working with Opera Memphis, for which she has performed in La Traviata, Carmen, Turandot, and many other operas. She looks forward to singing in the area more frequently, and especially teaching at Playhouse on the Square!
